The Department of Diagnostic Imaging is recruiting a fellowship trained Interventional Radiologist.

PRHC is a 400 bed regional centre. The DI department provides a full range of services in a modern facility opened in 2008. The Interventional Radiology division performs over 4,000 cases/year. There is a particularly busy regional vascular surgical and dialysis service supported by IR. There are two fully equipped Philips angio suites, with an adjacent 12 bed prep/recovery area. Two 64 slice Philips CT scanners are available as well.

The position includes provision of both Vascular and non vascular IR and general DI services, with flexible scheduling.

Peterborough is a welcoming and active community, the gateway to Kawartha Lakes cottage country. There is a vibrant arts and sporting community, with excellent public and private educational institutions. It is located just over an hour northeast of Toronto.
